# Practise, practise, practise!

Each week, you should be practising your key skills in reading, maths and spelling. This will really help you with your learning in the classroom. This should include:

- **Reading** with an adult 5 times each week with a discussion about the story/text. This should be recorded in your reading diary.
- **Times Table Rock Stars** 3-4 times each week for 5 minutes at a time. A little and often approach is key when practising times tables. You must be doing a least 1 Soundcheck per week.
- Doodle Maths once a week for further maths practice to consolidate learnt concepts.
- **Spelling practice**. You will have new spelling words every Monday. Practise 5 words from the year 3/4 group list and 5 words that follow the new spelling rule.
